## Goals

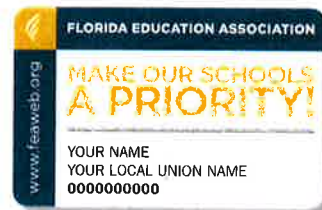
- » To preserve and improve retirement, pension and health benefits for all retired members and future members
