CCEA CONSTITUTION

**Article IV: Governing Authority
Section 3. Executive Committee**

1. The Executive Committee shall constitute the executive authority of the association. The Executive Committee shall develop and implement plans and programs to achieve the goals and promote the public policies adopted by the Representative Assembly.
2. Term of Office: All elected Directors shall take office on June 1, shall serve for a period of ~~two (2)~~ three (3) years per term, ~~and may succeed themselves three times.~~ All elections shall be in accordance with Bylaws, Article III.
~~STRIKE TWO (2) YEARS AND MAKE 3, AND STRIKE MAY SUCCEED THEMSELVES~~

Section 4. Officers

1. The elected officers of the Association shall be a President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, and a Treasurer.
2. Terms of Officer: All elected officers shall take office on June 1, and shall serve a term of ~~two (2)~~ three (3) years per term ~~and may succeed themselves only three (3) times for a total of six (6) consecutive years. The office may be held again after six (6) consecutive years only if the officer has not held the office for at least one term. Any vacant office may not be filled by appointment if in violation of the term limits stated above.~~

CCEA BY-LAWS

Article III: Officer Duties

Section 1: Vacancies: With the exception of the Presidency, all vacancies among Officers or Directors of the Association shall be appointments of the Executive Committee with majority approval of the Representative Assembly. Individuals shall serve for the unexpired portion of the term of vacant office. ~~Any vacant office may not be filled by appointment if in violation of the term limits stated above.~~ When a vacancy in the office of President occurs, the Vice President shall immediately fill the vacancy. The Executive Committee shall appoint an individual to fill the office of Vice President with the approval of the Representative Assembly.

If the Vice President is unable or unwilling to accept the Presidency, then the Executive Committee will select a President and present the candidate to the Representative Assembly for majority approval to serve the balance of the term.
